The Respiratory Therapist Educator, Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), is a knowledge translator and change agent who supports and participates in direct patient care as appropriate. You will act as a clinical resource for respiratory therapists and the interdisciplinary team and you will help us achieve excellence in clinical practice and quality patient care by:

- Working in collaboration with the Professional Practice Leader & Professional Practice Coordinator plans, implements and evaluates educational and clinical programs to meet the learning needs of respiratory therapy staff including orientation, clinical teaching, inservices and developing instructional materials.
